Spanish and Honors Math are also offered to students in grades 5-8. We are proud of the fact that our graduating 8th grade students routinely test into advanced courses entering high school.

Students attend Mass weekly and are actively involved in roles of service through monthly projects. They participate in school-wide prayer on a daily basis as well as regular study of scripture.
